Visit the Museum Gallery to catch a glimpse of graffiti left by men who were jailed for crimes from vagrancy to murder.

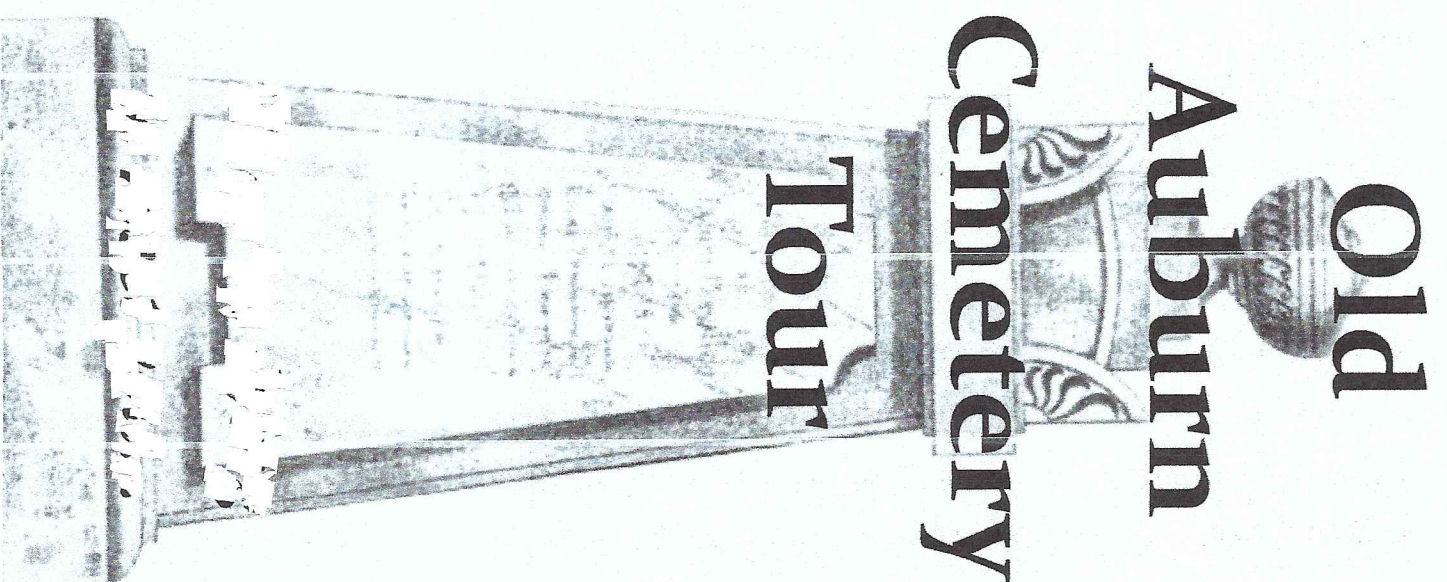
